Concept & Reasoning The term is broader than 'lamp.' In modern LED products the source may be integrated and non-replaceable, but the complete fixture remains the luminaire. The supporting pole and underground cable are parts of the lighting installation, not the luminaire itself. **How to Solve It in the Exam** Lamp is inside; luminaire is the whole fixture. **Important Exam Point** Use precise lighting vocabulary in design/specification questions. **Related Revision Path** This question sits in the revision path Building Electrical Services → Lighting → Lighting Terminology .
